## **WASHAKIE FARMER'S MARKET-GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**OBJECTIVE**; Washakie Farmer's Market is to have a fun, safe, enjoyable market for the public and vendors. The Market will be located at 9<sup>th</sup> Street between Worland City Hall and Pioneer Park. Days of operation are Saturdays, July 24, 31, August 7, 14, 21, 28 and September 4, 11, 18, 25th. Hours are from 8:30am to 2:00pm for Flea Market, Craft and Food Vendors. Hours are from 8:30am to 11:00am for produce vendors.

### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. All City of Worland, State of Wyoming, and United States of America laws and regulations will be followed and enforced.**
- 2. Vendors will be allowed to set up ½ hour before opening of the market. No set up after 8:30am. No vendor trucks may enter or leave the market area during market hours. Vendor parking will be at the North side of Security State Bank and the East side of Big Horn Federal Bank. For safety of customers and vendors, vendors must man their stalls the entire hours of operation.**
- 3. No early sales are allowed to customers before 8:30am. Sales to other vendors will be allowed during the set up time.**
- 4. Vendors will be responsible for set up, clean up and all items needed for their booth. All tents/canopies must be anchored and/or weighted down in case of strong wind or weather. Electricity is available on site for an additional cost of \$10 per week. Generators will not be allowed. All vendors must have product price signs and the vendors name sign posted on the booth.**
- 5. It is the vendor's responsibility to contact state and local officials where the market is located to find out about any additional licensing or tax requirements. Vendors are required to have proof of liability insurance.**
- 6. Booths shall be 10' X 10' at the cost of \$10 per day during the Farmer's Market. 10' X 20' booths are available for \$20 per day. Purchase five weeks and get one week free! Registration deadline for the first five week block is July 24, 2010. The second block deadline is August 27, 2010.**

**Booths will be assigned to all pre paid season vendors first, then on a first come first serve basis. One booth, per non profit organization, free of charge, rotating on a one day per season schedule will be allowed.**

**7. Craft products must be at least 80% hand made by the vendor. Craft vendors should not comprise more than 30% of the total booths leased on any given day.**

**8. Vendors will not hold the Washakie Farmer's Market, City of Worland, Washakie County or the State of Wyoming liable for any theft of their products or any injury while holding a booth at the market.**

**9. A map of booth assignments may be seen at the Worland Ten Sleep Chamber of Commerce. Booths may be paid for at the Worland Ten Sleep Chamber of Commerce or on the day of the market.**

**10. Any violation of the above rules and regulations on the first offense will result in a written warning from the market manager. Second offense will result in a meeting with the Rules and Regulations committee.**
